

The Tudors



A variety of original and replica objects to show aspects of life in Tudor times.

The resource also contains background information on the period including a study of Wollaton Hall, alongside copies and transcriptions of original manuscripts from the period.

Also included is a book of suggested activities and an information card for each object. These are all securely packed in conservation standard museum cases.

The resource contains the following objects

Original and replica coins, a pewter goblet, wooden trencher and bowl, pottery fragments, fox and geese game, various items of costume, model of Sir Francis Drake's Golden Hind ship, leather tankard and a ceramic bowl.

The resource can be used to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **history** in the following areas of **subject content**:

- KS1** *Events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally*
Significant historical events, people and places in their own locality
- KS2** *A study of an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066*
Local history study
- KS3** *The development of Church, state and society in Britain 1509-1745*
Local history study

The activity pack and supporting information contains activities and information that can be used to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **English, art and design, geography and drama** at **KS1 to 3**.
