

# Africa Inspires!



A variety of original objects and information to illustrate life and art in Africa and its influence on Britain.

The resource contains information on African life for both pupils and teachers, a book of suggested activities and an information card for each object. These are all securely packed in a conservation standard museum case.

## **The resource contains the following objects**

A barkcloth beater, carved wooden Akan doll, Wunkun figure, wooden bowl, tobacco pipe, miniature stool, wooden headrest, brass anklet, ivory bracelet, Poro society leopard claw, some wooden combs, a set of fabric samples and a set of Asante gold-dust weights.

The resource can be used to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **geography, English, history, art and design** and **drama** at **KS1 to 3**.
