

Bibi's Museum Adventure



This storytime resource has been developed around a specially commissioned book, *Bibi's Museum Adventure – The Princess and the Potter's Pot*, written by Panya Banjoko and illustrated by Samantha Mawby.

The resource focuses on a collection of museum objects which all have a link to Africa. It has been developed for pre-school and foundation age children, with the aim of engaging children with objects from other cultures, using them as a focus for learning.

The resource includes a Bibi doll, with original African objects and a selection of beautiful African costumes.

Also included is a specially developed, 24-page activity pack, along with copies of the story and other useful books. Each object also includes an information card.

This storytime resource has been developed for use with **early years** and **foundation** stage children.
