

# History Detectives

## Jesse Boot



A collection of original objects and information that tells the story of Jesse Boot, the famous Nottingham philanthropist and founder of the Boots pharmacy chain.

This resource contains written information on Boot's life for teachers and pupils, contemporary maps of Nottingham, resources from the Boots company archives, a book of suggested activities and an information card for each object. These are all securely packed in a conservation standard museum case.

### **The resource contains the following objects**

A 1914 copy of the Daily Mail, Boots first aid kit, candle, various Boots branded medicine tins and bottles, eye drops and ointments, syringe, pill making board, pestle, ceramic inhaler, stationery and an advertisement poster.

The resource can be used to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **history** in the following areas of **subject content**:

- KS1** *The lives of significant individuals in the past*  
*Significant historical events, people and places in their own locality*
- KS2** *An aspect or theme in British history that consolidates and extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066*  
*Local history study*
- KS3** *Ideas, political power, industry and empire: Britain 1745-1901*  
*Local history study*

The activity pack and supporting information contains activities and information that can be used to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **English, art and design, geography** and **drama** at **KS1 to 3**.
