


The Ancient Greeks



A variety of original and replica objects to illustrate life in Ancient Greece. The resource contains examples of Ancient Greek recipes and information cards on various themes including drama, language and costume.

Also included is a timeline, book of suggested activities and an information card for each object.

These are all securely packed in conservation standard museum cases.

The resource contains the following objects

An aryballos oil flask and lamp, domestic plate and bowls, coins, cosmetic bowl, skyphos cup and an oinochoe jug.



The resource can be used to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **history** in the following areas of **subject content**:

- **KS1** Events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally
- **KS2** Ancient Greece a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.
- **KS3** Study of a significant society or issue in world history and its interconnections with other world developments.

The activity pack and supporting information contains activities and information that can be used to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **English**, **art and design**, **geography** and **drama** at **KS1** to **3**.
