The Native Americans



A variety of original and replica objects from Native American Indian culture. The resource contains information on Native American clothing, hairstyles, houses, spiritual traditions and the different tribes.

Also included is a book of suggested activities and an information card for each object. These are all securely packed in conservation standard museum cases.

The resource contains the following objects

A cradle board, water carrier, snow shoe (with information on how they were traditionally made), harpoon with arrow and quiver, powder horn, shirt with boots and moccasins, stone arrowheads and traditional raven carving.

- KS1 Events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally
- **KS3** Study of a significant society or issue in world history and its interconnections with other world developments.

The activity pack and supporting information contains activities and information that can be used to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **English**, **art and design**, **geography** and **drama** at **KS1** to **3**.
