

## The Rock Box



Developed in conjunction with the East Midlands Geological Association, this resource is a collection of minerals and fossils. The resource contains information on the different forms of rocks, the rock cycle and the formation of fossils, as well as a geological timescale and map of Western Europe. Each sample in the resource comes with an information card.

The resource also contains a UV lightbox for observing the changes in the fluorescent rocks when exposed to different forms of light. These are all securely packed in conservation standard museum cases.

## The minerals and fossils represented in the resource include

Plesiosaur, ammonite, trilobite, sandstone, limestone, slate, fluorite, ruby, common opal, amethyst and citrine samples, among many others.



The resource has been developed to meet the requirements of the national curriculum for **science** at **KS1-3**
